





OCTOBER IS NATIONAL CHIROPRACTIC HEALTH MONTH

SPOTLIGHT ON CHIROPRACTIC HEALTH



A healthy spine is an often overlooked and essential part of a healthy lifestyle. People who suffer from back pain, particularly if it is long-term, are generally less healthy than those who do not. In fact, back pain costs are staggering not only financially, but also in terms of lost time from work and because of psychosocial problems that arise during the healing process associated with long-term back pain.

Unfortunately, approximately 80-90% of the population suffers from spinal pain at some point. People who are overweight or obese, and who smoke, lift heavy objects, or had a previous episode of back pain, are more likely to experience back pain.

Because so many people suffer from spine pain, it's important for you to try to keep your spine as healthy as possible. Following simple posture, lifting, and healthy lifestyle guidelines can help you keep your back in good shape.

The American Chiropractic Association recommends the following spinal health tips:



Standing

When standing, keep one foot slightly in front of the other, with your knees slightly bent. This position helps to take the pressure off your low back. Do not stand bent forward at the waist for prolonged periods of time. The muscles in your low back become deconditioned in this position, which may lead to pain.

Lifting

At all times, avoid twisting while lifting. Twisting is one of the most dangerous movements for your spine, especially while lifting. If the item is too heavy to lift, pushing it is easier on your back than pulling it. Whenever possible, use your legs, not your back or upper body, to push the item. If you must lift a heavy item, get someone to help you.

Sitting

Keep your knees slightly higher than your hips, with your head up and back straight. Avoid rolling your shoulders forward (slouching). Try to maintain the natural curve in your low back.

Reaching and Bending

When reaching for something above shoulder level, stand on a stool. Straining to reach such objects may not only hurt your mid-back and neck, but it can also bring on shoulder problems. Do NOT bend over at the waist to pick up items from the floor or a table. Instead, kneel down on one knee, as close as possible to the item you are lifting, with the other foot flat on the floor and pick the item up. Or bend at the knees, keep the item close to your body, and lift with your legs, not your back.

Carrying

When carrying objects, particularly if they are heavy, keep them as close to your body as possible. Carrying two small objects—one in each hand—is often easier to handle than one large one.

Healthy Diet and Exercise

While the proverbial jury is still out, we suspect that extra weight puts undue strain on your spine. Keep within 10 lbs. of your ideal weight for a healthier back. "Beer belly" is likely the worst culprit, as it puts unwanted pressure on the muscles, ligaments and tendons in your low back. The most efficient and effective way to reduce weight is by eating a sensible diet and exercising regularly. Consult with your doctor before beginning any exercise program, particularly if you have a health condition.

Sleeping

Sleeping on your back puts approximately 50 pounds of pressure on your spine. Other positions may be better. Placing a pillow under your knees while lying on your back cuts the pressure on your spine roughly in half. Lying on your side with a pillow between your knees may also reduce the pressure on your back.

Never sleep in a position that causes a portion of your spine to hurt. Most often, your body will tell you what position is best.

Journal: ask yourself "what baggage am I holding on to and why?" Write it in a journal as often as you like.







WHY APPLE KILLED THE HEADPHONE JACK

SPOTLIGHT ON COMPUTING

With the unveiling of the iPhone 7, the usual chatter about the latest features seems to be dominated by the seemingly odd design decision that Apple will eliminate the traditional 3.5mm analog headphone jack on all of its new devices in favor of the Lightning connector or their new proprietary wireless technology.

They actually aren't the first smartphone maker to make this decision as Chinese manufacturer LeEco and the Moto Z line from Lenovo (formerly Motorola) have already eliminated the headphone jack.

The iPhone 7 will ship with Lightning earbuds and a special 'dongle' that converts the lighting connector at the bottom to a standard headphone jack so you can still use older headphones.

Better Audio

Apple wants to get away from analog technology that was created in the 1960's and use a more advanced digital audio output. The Lightning connector at the bottom of the phone

is capable of providing more than just a way to charge the iPhone and digital audio is just one option.

While the new Lightning headphones are certainly capable of delivering higher fidelity audio, I'm not sure the average listener will hear the difference, especially if the quality of the audio file isn't all that great. Many companies, including Apple, are trying to roll out higher fidelity music services, so having higher fidelity headphones is a natural part of their strategy.

More Room Inside

Another benefit of getting rid of the headphone jack is that it frees up space inside the phone itself. Space is extremely tight in all smartphones, so every millimeter counts, especially when it comes to something as large as a 3.5 mm headphone jack. That extra space can be devoted to larger screens, bigger batteries, better antennas or a slimmer form factor.

The Wireless Future

We must remember that Apple was the



first computer company to get rid of floppy disk drives and CD/DVD drives in their computers and in the name of innovation, the headphone jack had to go. Unveiled along with the iPhone 7 were the new AirPod wireless earbuds, which uses proprietary wireless technology and will sell for \$159.

Apple knew that relying on the current Bluetooth standard for wireless audio would be too problematic, so they chose to create their own wireless connectivity technology to make thing easier and more reliable.

3 Billion More Reasons

Many analysts scratched their heads when Apple agreed to pay \$3 billion to acquire headphone maker Beats, but it's now a little clearer how they plan to leverage that acquisition. Whether you end up using Lightning headphones or the wireless earbuds, they're both going to be more expensive than traditional headphones which plays right into Apple's 'premium products' strategy.

Initial Concerns

Some of the initial concerns being voiced over this radical change include the inability to listen to music while charging the phone, owning headphones that only work on Apple devices, losing the special dongle or if you opt for the expensive wireless earbuds, losing them (they aren't much bigger than traditional hearing aids) and having yet another thing to remember to recharge.

"The scleral contact lens compensates for the absence of a smooth corneal surface by providing what is, in essence, a new, enhanced ocular surface much smoother than the one that the patient presently had," states Dr. Eric R. Straut, Optometric Physician and Low Vision Specialist at The Eye Institute for Medicine & Surgery.

"This is important both for comfort and vision as the surface of the eye bends light in a way that brings images into focus," explains Dr. Straut, adding, "a smooth surface can help produce clear images, whereas a rough surface may create images that are blurry or distorted."

"The new smooth surface created by the scleral contact lens bends light in a manner that was intended to help many people optimize their visual potential and eliminate blurriness and distortion they were previously forced to endure," adds Dr. Mandese.

TREATMENT FOR DRY EYES - AN ADDITIONAL BENEFIT OF SCLERAL CONTACT LENSES

Patients with severe dry eyes, often as a result of systemic disease or the use of certain medications are another group of people who may greatly benefit from a specialized scleral contact lens fitting.

"Patients with Sjogren's syndrome, rheumatoid arthritis, lupus, sarcoid, Crohn's disease, irritable bowel syndrome, or one of many other autoimmune diseases often experience the most severe forms of dry eye syndrome," according to Dr. Straut.

"Symptoms of dry eye syndrome include severe dryness, foreign body sensation, blurring of vision, or surprisingly to many, excessive tearing," states Dr. Straut. "Patients are often surprised when I explain that the source of their excessive tearing is actually dry eye syndrome," remarked Dr. Straut.

"If your eyes feel dry, oftentimes the body attempts to compensate for this dryness by sending out more tears," explains Dr. Mandese, adding "unfortunately the quality of these tears is poor. This is why, in some cases, more and more tears are sent to the eye, leaving the patient with fluctuating vision, uncomfortable and unhappy."

"With full coverage of the eye and the lack of exposure to wind and circulating air, and with the eye being bathed in preservative free saline solution throughout the day, patients with severe dry eyes who have received a custom scleral contact lens fit often experience greatly improved comfort," states Dr. Mandese.

CUSTOM FITTING HELPS OPTIMIZE RESULTS

Using the latest technology, computerized scanning devices take multiple measurements across the surface of the eye to ensure a custom fit is made to help each patient to realize his or her maximum visual potential and ocular comfort.

"It's truly inspiring when a patient tells me that our efforts have not only improved their vision and comfort, but that their quality of life is substantially better due to the care we have provided at The Eye Institute for Medicine & Surgery," explains Dr. Straut.

"Compared to traditional "hard" or "gas permeable" contact lenses, the new scleral contact lenses are extremely comfortable in the eye," explains Dr. Straut.

"Unlike traditional hard or even soft lenses that move about in the eye when a person blinks, scleral contact lenses move only minimally. Honest John's

By South Brevard Historical Society

After fighting in the Civil War, former soldiers traveled along the Indian River Lagoon seeking a quiet place to settle down and begin a new life. Of the many locations homesteaded during the late 1800's, two of the more interesting sites were the Smith and Latham properties.

Leaving Georgia for Florida in 1887, brothers Robert Toombs Smith and Charley Smith spent the last leg of their trip sailing along the eastern shore line of the Indian River Lagoon to the mouth of Mullet Creek where they laid claim to 159 acres. The site is approximately 5 miles north of Sebastian Inlet and known today as oHonest John's Fish Camp. The brothers cleared the land by hand for a house and an area to grow produce, which would become their business. The 2-story house, built with local materials such as heart pine for siding and floors and coquina for pilings, still stands today. The family grew and shipped



produce until Robert's third son, "Honest" John, grew up and changed the family business to commercial fishing. Today the homestead is known as a great place for fishing and kayaking www. honestjohnsfishcamp.com.

In 1800-1801, Oak Lodge was built on the eastern shore of the Indian River Lagoon opposite of what is now the city of Grant. Charles Latham purchased a 164 acre property and had a ten room wooden structure built to house scientists who traveled to the area to study the local plants and animals. He and his wife Frances lived on the property and often participated in the research. A fire destroyed the original building in 1893.

The second building burned in May, 1910 on an especially memorable night. Halley's Comet was visible in the sky above the burning building as one looked from the western shore. The land is now occupied by the Aquarina Golf Course.

At the next meeting of the South Brevard Historical Society, Barbara Arthur, daughter of Honest John Smith, will take us through the fascinating history of Brevard's South Beaches, Honest John's Fish Camp and Oak Lodge. This free presentation is open to the public and will be on October 8th from 3:00pm – 4:00pm at the Melbourne Public Library, 540 E. Fee Ave., Melbourne, Florida 32902.
