DOES BACK PAIN GO AWAY ON ITS OWN?

SPOTLIGHT ON CHIROPRACTIC HEALTH




Eighty percent of people suffer from back pain at some point in their lives. Back pain is the second most common reason for visits to the doctor's office, outnumbered only by upper-respiratory infections. Most cases of back pain are mechanical or non-organic, ai.e., not caused by serious conditions, such as inflammatory arthritis, infection, fracture, or cancer.

What Causes Back Pain?

The back is a complicated structure of bones, joints, ligaments, and muscles. You can sprain ligaments, strain muscles, rupture disks, and irritate joints, all of which can lead to back pain. While sports injuries or accidents can cause back pain, sometimes the simplest of movements-for example, picking up a pencil from the floor-can have painful results. In addition, arthritis, poor posture, obesity, and psychological stress can cause or complicate back pain. Back pain can also directly result from disease of the internal organs, such as kidney stones, kidney infections, blood clots, or bone loss.

Back injuries are a part of everyday life, and the spine is quite good at dealing with these often "pulled" muscles. These



very minor injuries usually heal within 1 or 2 days. Some pain, however, continues. What makes some pain last longer is not entirely understood, but researchers suspect that the reasons may include stress, mood changes, and the fear of further injury that may prevent patients from being active. In addition, sometimes a painful injury or disease changes the way the pain signals are sent through the body, and, even after the problem has gone away or is inactive, the pain signals still reach the brain. It is as if the pain develops a memory that keeps being replayed.

Will Back Pain Go Away on Its Own?

Until recently, researchers believed that back pain will "heal" on its own. We have learned, however, that this is not true. A recent study showed that when back pain is not treated, it may go away temporarily but will most likely return. The study demonstrated that in more than 33% of the people who experience low-back pain, the pain lasts for more than 30 days. Only 9% of the people who had low-back pain for more than 30 days were pain free 5 years later.

Another study looked at all of the available research on the natural history of low-back pain. The results showed that when it is ignored, back pain does not go away on its own. Those studies demonstrate that low-back pain continues to affect people for long periods after it first begins.

What Can I Do to Prevent Long-Term Back Pain?

If your back pain is not resolving quickly, visit your doctor of chiropractic. Your pain will often result from mechanical problems that your doctor of chiropractic can address. Many chiropractic patients with relatively long-lasting or recurring back pain feel improvement shortly after starting chiropractic treatment. The relief they feel after a month of treatment is often greater than after seeing a family physician.

If you must sit for long periods, take frequent breaks and stretch.

Wear flat shoes or shoes with low heels.

Exercise regularly. An inactive lifestyle contributes to lower-back pain.







UNDERSTANDING WINDOWS 10 ANNIVERSARY UPDATE

SPOTLIGHT ON COMPUTING

The Windows 10 Anniversary Update is a combination of bug fixes and feature updates and that would likely have been called a 'service pack' in the past. Whether you love or hate Windows 10, it's the future of the platform and with it comes many changes to the way we're all used to working with Microsoft.

To better understand this update, it's important to understand the changes in the way Microsoft is going to support and update Windows from now on. For starters, Microsoft has referred to Windows 10 as 'the last version of Windows' not because they plan to abandon Windows altogether, but because they plan to abandon the numeric upgrade cycles that they have followed since the very first version was released.

Instead of creating completely new versions with new numbers on disks that you buy, Microsoft is following Apple's approach of delivering all future Windows upgrades as downloads. Microsoft's ambition is to get you thinking of the Windows interface like you do Gmail or Facebook, where upgrades to the platform 'just happen'.

The business case for this shift in approach is very clear: Microsoft doesn't want to have to support multiple old versions of Windows decades after they are released like they're having to do today. They want to get everyone on one platform so they don't have to employ different programmers to support old versions that users have chosen not to upgrade.

If you look at the current global OS market share numbers, you'll better understand Microsoft's problem:

Windows 7 - 47%

Windows 10 - 21%

Windows XP - 10%

Windows 8.1 - 8%

Windows 8 - 2%

Of the five versions listed above, only one is no longer supported (Windows XP) yet there are as many users still



using XP as there are using 8 and 8.1 combined. Microsoft knows today's users are much less inclined to make a change to their operating system than in the past, so they want to control all of that in the future.

This brings us to the current state of Windows updates for anyone who is using Windows 10 – they're just going to happen. If you're tech savvy and don't mind dealing with new issues, you can manually download the Windows 10 Anniversary Update (https://goo.gl/hWNxAd), which was released on August 2, but for most, I'd recommend waiting for the auto-update process to deliver it.


We have seen a few issues in our tests of the Anniversary Update, especially with third-party software like security programs and there are the usual early complaints posted in various tech forums outlining various other issues.

Many of these issues will be resolved as third-party software vendors work through the compatibility issues and provide updates of their software to work with this new Windows update.

There are many interesting new features and tweaks included in the Anniversary Update, but I wouldn't hurry to download it just yet.free trial both services offer before you 'cut the cord'.

5 Low-Calorie Snacks

Nonfat Greek yogurt also tends to have less sugar than traditional yogurts, and



its creamy texture gives many people the impression that they are eating something decadent.

- 3. Hummus: Made primarily from ground chickpeas, hummus is a proteinand fiber-rich snack that has been linked to a host of health benefits, including a reduced risk for heart disease and certain types of cancers. Dip vegetables such as baby carrots into hummus, and you'll have a low-calorie snack that's also high in vitamin A and beta carotene.
- **4. Pistachios:** Many people might read the labels of pistachios and be turned off by the fat content. But pistachios are low in saturated fat and high in protein, and a couple dozen pistachios may only amount to about 95 calories. Eat pistachios raw and do not add salt, which can negate their health benefits.
- **5. Grapes:** Grapes might not be as popular as potato chips or other widely available snacks, but they are great sources of vitamin K and are loaded with antioxidants. Grapes are loaded with water, making them a filling snack that can help men and women avoid dehydration. According to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, one cup of grapes can provide as much as 5 percent of the recommended daily value of dietary fiber despite containing just over 100 calories



Learning History by RECREATING THE EVENT

by South Brevard Historical Society

September is the month that children return to school and begin a year of focused learning in subjects that will give them the foundation to be productive members of society. One of these kids may be the first to settle a colony off our planet. It is impressive to me that only 456 years separated the time

of Juan Ponce de Leon's landing on Florida (1513) and Neil Armstrong's landing on the moon (1969). We are very fortunate to be in an area where access to sites that "tell" the history of both events and the countless events in between are within a day's drive.

Florida shores were one of the destinations of European explorers to the newly discovered Americas. The



logs and writings of that time tell the story of these explorations. One can get a sense of what it was like to approach the coast by taking a cruise from the Cape Canaveral Port and then be outside as the ship is heading back to port to see when you first site land.

Recreating a historical event gives participants an even deeper insight into what

the people of the time might have experienced. In September 1962, a crew of 9 men boarded a replica of Columbus's ship Nina (fittingly named Nina II) and set sail from Spain and traveled to San Salvador (Marx, Robert, The Voyage of the Nina II, Gulf Pub. Co, 1991). Serving as the ship's navigator and the only America on board, Robert Marx, underwater

archeologist and author, documented this 77-day crossing. After successfully making the crossing, Robert Marx was made a Knight-commander in the Order of Isabella the Catholic by the Spanish government.

Sir Robert Marx will detail this reenactment of Christopher Columbus' first voyage to the America's in a program titled "The Voyage if the Nina II". This very interesting program is the first of South Brevard's Historical Society's 2016-2017 season and will be held at the Melbourne Public Library (540 E. Fee Ave., Melbourne, Florida 32902) on September 10th from 3:00pm – 4:00pm.

Hire a professional property management company. Often times, a good property manager will have an attorney that they work with that can help with lease preparation, legal questions and eviction proceedings, in addition to handling routine and emergency maintenance. A good management company can save you both time and money in the long run.

Not the Doctor!

You can hardly pick up a newspaper these days without seeing a group of my hearing care colleagues all posing in their spiffy white lab coats. Some of them even have the word 'medical' in their businesses names.

One even poses with an eye doctor, in their white lab coat, looking over their shoulders, as though they are consulting over a patient's case. Others pose in front of their certification, licenses, and degrees, all in their spiffy white lab coats.

Many show pictures of hearing aids with incredibly low prices, and tiny print explaining that the prices shown only apply if you have the very mildest of hearing loss. Most have the word FREE plastered several times across their offerings, leading you to believe that there might just be something for nothing. Though common sense will tell you that those ads don't come cheap, and you know who is going to pay for them in the end.

All of these ads, and colleagues, have one thing in common, they are playing on the authority given medical doctors when they pronounce a treatment plan, and those showing a lowball price on any gear, are trying to pull a bait, and switch.

In every case they are working from a medical model of dispensing that proceeds from the idea that you will follow whatever the person in the white lab coat dictates, as you'll associate what they say with the weight of a medical prognosis, and treatment plan.

When dealing with these colleagues you can expect a distinctly medical style approach to come with the white lab coat, and many actually operate from within medical practices, or eye clinics.

Now, there is nothing wrong with the medical model of dispensing per se. I actually have my own white lab coat, though it's been hanging on the back of the door to my office for so long that the

shoulders are gray with dust.

However, the recently released report by the National Academy of Sciences, known as the PCAST report, commissioned by the President to

answer the questions of how to improve hearing care access, and affordability found that our industry, and profession had "erected significant barriers to both access, and affordability." These take on the form of those add-on protocols, and costs associated with the highly regulated delivery system that emerged along with that medical model, and white lab coat.




The Senior Behavioral Wellness program will offer services on a voluntary basis; individuals seeking admission must have capacity and be able to make informed decisions about their treatment.


The average length of stay is approximately 12 to 14 days and may vary according to the individual needs of the patient.
