HOW TO IMPACT THE WORLD

Impact. It's an important word in our culture right now. I read an article recently from Money magazine about a study done on valedictorians and salutatorians and their impact on society after high school. They concluded that none of the valedictorians or salutatorians chose a career that impacted the world after high school. They were stable, had seemingly great lives and great careers, but none chose to make an impact on the world.

Their sample size was very small (only 81 people, when

there are about 27,000 high schools in America that turn out 54,000 of these every year), but it brought up an interesting point (actually by leaving it out).

What is considered making an impact? Who makes that distinction? Impact isn't really judged in the middle of the action, but years after, while measuring the result. That characteristic makes it hard to define it as it is happening. How do we make an impact on the world?

Their is one person in the world who maximized his impact better than anyone else who has ever lived. Nearly 2000 years after his death, the things that he said are driving the political, economical and cultural machines more than any other one person ever on the planet. Of course, I'm talking about Jesus Christ. Helping others who can't help themselves wasn't a popular value on the planet until he pushed it. So many of the values that we have, whether we are Christ followers or not, are rooted in what Jesus taught.

So how did he make this amazing impact on the planet? He invested in people, one at a time. He valued them, above his own physical needs. He lived by a set of



principles that were unselfish and extraordinary, They flew in the face of culture and popular thought, and no government could destroy them. Ultimately, so much so, that he died to save them. When a government destroyed his body, his impact grew. People were so impacted by his life that the more they were persecuted and oppressed for following him, the more people joined the movement. Whether you believe that he was the Son of God, that's an impressive resume.

He never ran for office in the political arena or ruled a country. He never was the CEO of a global corporation. He never was inducted into a sports Hall of Fame. He never even owned a house to live in, or anything more than the clothes on his back, but two millennia later, the impact that he made on the planet is undeniable. That's a worthy example of how to impact the world, investing in one life at a time...and he wasn't a valedictorian or salutatorian.

Gas Grill Safety TIPS

Backyard barbecues are a warm weather tradition.

While some brave men and women grill year-round, many reserve their outdoor cooking to those times of year when the weather fully cooperates.

The laid back vibes of spring, summer and early fall can make

it easy for grillmasters to overlook safety when cooking outside. But grilling requires that cooks prioritize safety.

While both charcoal and gas grills can cause fires, the National Fire Protection Association says gas grills contributed to four out of five gas grill fires. The NFPA also notes that many of those gas grill-related fires can be traced to leaks or breaks in the hoses. The following are a handful of ways cooks can safeguard themselves, their families, their grills, and their homes against leaks or breaks in their gas grill hoses.

- Inspect hoses at the start of each grilling season. Leaks, breaks or cracks
 in the hoses may occur when moving grills into the garage or shed for the
 winter. So it's a good idea to inspect the hoses at the start of each season
 before using the grill for the first time each year.
- Employ soap and water if you suspect but cannot find any leaks. Travelers
 Insurance recommends that men and women who suspect a leak is present
 but cannot find one apply a light solution of soap and water to the hose. If
 there is a leak, bubbles will appear.
- Do not turn on the gas if the grill lid is closed. If the gas is turned on while
 the lid is closed, gas can build up inside and potentially ignite, causing the
 lid to blow off. So men and women should always make sure the lids of
 their grills are open before turning on the gas.
- Stop grilling if you smell gas and see no flame. If there is no flame, but you still smell gas, turn off the tank and grill immediately. Some leaks may cease, at which time men and women can take their tanks to be serviced. If the leak persists, contact the local fire department.
- Turn off the grill and cease cooking if you smell gas while food is on the grill. The odor of gas while cooking is another telltale sign of a leak, even if there is a flame and food appears to be cooking. Contact the local fire department if such a situation presents itself.
- Close the valve after cooking. Always make sure the valve is tightly closed after cooking.

Grilling with gas can make for delicious meals, but men and women must prioritize safety around their gas grills to prevent fires and other accidents.



BACK TO SCHOOL NUTRITION

SPOTLIGHT ON CHIROPRACTIC HEALTH

As a new school year approaches, I want to remind parents of the important role nutrition plays in assuring kids a successful school year. Nutrition and learning go hand in hand. Kids who are nutritionally fit are more likely to have the energy, stamina and self-esteem that enhance their ability to learn. Running out the door with thoughts of seeing old classmates, joining new clubs, participating in school sports and (hopefully!) getting good grades, kids will not be paying much attention to the proper nutrition needed to accomplish all of this.

We have often heard it said that breakfast is the most important meal of the day, yet 35-40 percent of all Americans skip breakfast. The statistics for children are just as alarming, as many as 48 percent of girls and 32 percent of boys do not eat breakfast every day. Start with a healthy breakfast. For children and teens a morning meal is especially important to prepare them to meet the challenges of learning. Many studies have shown that those who eat a

morning meal tend to perform better in school, score higher on tests, have higher school attendance, less tardiness, better concentration and muscle coordination...



and kids who eat breakfast have fewer hunger induced stomachaches and are less likely to be overweight.

As for lunch, meals served at school contribute significantly to kids overall nutrient and energy needs. Do you know what they are eating? School meals are usually regulated through the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA). Through USDA guidance many schools are improving the nutritional quality of lunch and designing the meals to supply about one-third of a child's nutrition needs.

Parents can play a role in helping a child choose healthful meals in several ways. Keep the school lunch menu in your kitchen, go over it with your child, and talk with your child about making choices in the cafeteria line. Get involved and work with school staff to form a parent advisory committee for the school food service program.

If your child prefers to brown bag it to school, let your child help plan and prepare school lunches. When they're involved, chances are they will resist trading their carrots for cookies. Pack meals that are easy to prepare and fun to eat as well as nutritious. A few examples are sandwiches, raw veggies, crackers, string cheese, whole fruit and yogurt or pudding.

Finally, for after-school snacks choose foods that supply needed nutrients that can be missed in meal choices. Stock up with ready-to-eat fruits and vegetables, animal crackers, popcorn and cereal. Your child will appreciate the availability of quick healthy snacks.

Well why not, after all Ice tea, after water, is the most frequently consumed beverage in the world. But In fact on any given day, more than half of the American population drinks tea and 85% of the tea consumed in the US is served iced. In the Southern States, including Florida, that percentage of this tasty libation goes up particularly during the summer time. Yep, summer time is Iced Tea Time in Florida. It is a great way to stay hydrated and get needed fluid and minerals. Whether black, green, white all of which come from the same plant, just processed differently - all fresh made teas do a body good.

Weather hot or cold fresh made tea is chock full of healthful things. There has been much research done that shows tea can reduce the risk of heart disease, help reduce weight and provide useful antioxidants for your system to help support a healthy lifestyle.

Unfortunately, store bought ice tea beverages, even the refrigerated ones, despite being claims of being made of great stuff, are little more than tea flavored beverages

these beverages are loaded with artificial preservatives, stabilizers and other chemicals used in the food industry to maintain color, palatability and self-life which are of questionable value.

Making fine ice tea at home is a snap. Three ways to make great ice tea: as a Sun-Tea, hot brew or cold brew. The basic proportions are 1 ounce fine loose-leaf tea to 1 gallon of good quality water. 

Peanut Butter Cupcakes

1pkg Devil's food cake mix (Dunkin Hines is what I use but you can use any box cake mix)

1pkg Jell-O Vanilla Instant Pudding

1 cup Milk

1/2 cup Peanut Butter
1 1/2 cup COOL WHIP

4 sq. Semi-Sweet Chocolate

1/2 cup Dry roasted peanuts chopped

Line your cupcake pan with the cupcake paper cups. Set oven to 350 degrees. Follow cake mix box to make batter. Then pour into cupcake pan. When cooked cool for a half hour.

Now beat pudding mix and milk until it is all blended then add peanut butter and mix it till it is well combined. Take a plastic freezer bag and spoon mixture in. Now cut the tip off of one bottom side of bag. Insert tip into center of each cupcake and pipe (about a tablespoon full).

In a microwave bowl add chocolate on High for 1 1/2 min or longer until melted. Dip tops of cupcake in the glaze and add nuts on top.

Financial Management



DON'T BE A MEMORY HOG SPOTLIGHT ON COMPUTING

Tabbed browsing changed the way we use the Internet and has become both
a blessing and a curse. If you spend
time gathering information from multiple
sources while researching anything
online, this feature has been a game
changer.

Being able to open additional tabs eliminated the need to hit the 'back' and 'forward' buttons in order to jump from one page to another, but the downside to this convenience is the memory usage.

Every tab you open consumes working memory (aka RAM) which can eventually lead to significant performance issues, so keeping the number of open tabs to a minimum is always in your best interest.

There are many variables involved in determining actual memory usage, so the various testing sites that proclaim one browser over another may not be applicable to you unless you use your browser the exact same way that it was tested.

If I had to make a general recommendation, Firefox for Windo users and Safari for Mac users seem have the lowest memory usage base on a compilation of various tests.

Changing Your Behavior

If you can change the way you manage open tabs, you won't have to consider changing browsers. As convenient as it may be to have a tab open all day with Facebook running in the background, if you can do without it, you can save memory. Bookmarking your commonly-used sites for easy access and remembering that you can quickly reopen recently closed tabs in most browsers by hitting Ctrl-Shft-T should help you feel better about closing idle tabs.

Sniffing Out Memory Hogs

Different web resources will use different amounts of memory, so if you want to see how much memory a specific site is taking up, most browsers offer a way to do that. In Chrome, hitting Shift-Esc will open Google's Task Manager, which lists all of your open tabs along



with various details. If you click on the 'Memory' heading, it will re-sort your open tabs in order of the largest memory usage.

Internet Explorer provides the information as a pop-up that you have to open on each page by hitting Control-Shift-U (hitting it again will close the pop-up). Firefox users can install an addon called Tab Memory Usage (https://goo.gl/DXtBuK) (https://goo.gl/DXtBuK) which will display the memory usage of each page in the upper right section of the browser window. By identifying the memory hogs in your regular rotation, you'll know which ones to close first if things start to slow down.

For 'Tabaholics'

If there's no possibility for you to change your tabbing behavior, then adding more RAM or installing add-ons may be a better solution to allow for lots of tabs. Chrome users can try The Great Suspender (https://goo.gl/DCj4Gt) (https://goo.gl/DCj4Gt), which will automatically suspend unused tabs to free up memory. Both Firefox and Opera users can try Tab Suspender (https://goo.gl/9sDEcs) (https://goo.gl/9sDEcs) to accomplish the same thing.

Unnecssary Add-Ons

Add-Ons also contribute to memory usage, so avoid installing them if you don't really need them and disable or get rid of the ones you may have already installed that you don't use.



FAST Action Saves Sight

Retinal Detachments: What you don't know could cost you your vision.

very year, nearly 25,000 people in the United States experience retinal detachments, a true medical emergency that can threaten their sight. For some, symptoms begin gradually and may be barely noticeable. Others will experience a sudden and dramatic decrease in their vision, creating an obvious urgency to seek care. "There is no question that a retinal detachment left untreated can lead

detachment left untreated can lead to vision loss that can become permanent in the absence of timely and expert care," states Gary J. Ganiban, MD, chief of vitreoretinal surgery at The Eye Institute for Medicine & Surgery.

The retina is a thin, interior layer of tissue at the back of the eye. Its job is to process light through special cells called photoreceptors that detect


qualities such as color and light-intensity. That information is sent through the optic nerve from the retina to the brain, which creates the images we see.

Retinal detachment occurs when the retina pulls away from its normal position

and is cut off from nourishing blood vessels. The interior of the retina also can be harmed by the appearance of tears or holes, conditions that may progress when left untreated.

Dr. Ganiban emphasizes that whether the retina is affected by a small tear or full detachment, the injury can occur suddenly and without warning. "There is no pain or redness of the eye associated with these conditions," notes the doctor.

"However, in many cases, there are warning signs, and these signs should not be ignored," adds Dr. Ganiban. Patients with retinal detachments may experience sudden changes in their field of vision. They may notice an increased number of tiny specks called *floaters*, which may seem like moving cobwebs, strings or strands. Some have described what looks like a curtain coming down

over a portion of their vision.

These symptoms can occur before the retina fully detaches, explains Hetal D. Vaishnav, MD, director of clinical research and preventive medicine at The Eye Institute for Medicine & Surgery.

This is when time will be critical.

"If a patient or referring doctor suspects a retinal detachment, a key to heling ensure that vision is maintained or regained is to schedule an examination with a retinal specialist as soon as possible," advises Dr. Vaishnav.

"The bottom line is that in many cases, a thorough, dilated eye examination will reveal the retinal hole or tear prior to it developing into a full detachment.

"Then a procedure can be performed through a laser or freezing probe to seal the tear and help prevent any further separation of the retina," assures Dr. Vaishnav.

Gentler repair procedure

A trend in retinal surgery to repair retinal detachments has been to move away from a treatment known as scleral buckle and toward a procedure called vitrectomy. A scleral buckle involves placement of a tiny device on the eye's outer surface that helps close the retinal break. Vitrectomy removes most of the vitreous, the clear, gel-like substance inside the eye.

Vitrectomy offers numerous advantages for most patients who

need surgery for retinal detachment, says Dr. Ganiban. One is that removing the vitreous reduces traction on the repaired retinal tear. This makes future retinal tears less likely.

The vitrectomy procedure frequently takes less time than other methods, which often means the risk of complications is reduced, he adds.

"Vitrectomy surgeries heal relatively rapidly due to minimal surgical trauma," states Dr. Ganiban. "Very little cutting is required, and frequently stitches aren't required. Compared to a scleral buckle, vitrectomy is very gentle.

"Another advantage of vitrectomy is that the shape of the eye isn't altered and therefore there shouldn't be a change in the patient's eyeglass prescription. With a scleral buckle, the eye may become elongated, causing induced myopia, which is nearsightedness, and/or a visually significant astigmatism."

The Ganihand for better view

A medical innovation developed on the Space Coast by Dr. Ganiban is now aiding eye surgeons during vitrectomy procedures. The surgeon's view of the back of the eye and affected structures is critical during retinal repairs. Traditionally, this enhanced view is achieved with the help of a surgical technician. The technician applies slight pressure to the sclera, the eye's outer, white surface, with a cotton tip applicator or scleral depressor made of stainless steel. The surgeon can then see the back of the eve through the patient's well-dilated pupil.

This method is decades-old but can be cumbersome and inefficient. In most cases, it increases the length of the surgery.

Dr. Ganiban knew there had to be a better way and designed a handsfree scleral depressor device. During surgery, the instrument is secured to the speculum that keeps the patient's eye propped open. It features a custom light pipe to ensure the surgeon has an ideal view of the interior eye without the need for a surgical assistant.

There are now multiple versions and sizes of the Ganihand in development to ensure the device will be suitable for all related surgical applications. "It is my sincere hope that my new instrument will help surgeons all over the United States and the world to improve their surgical outcomes, minimize complications and restore vision that otherwise may not have been regained," says Dr. Ganiban.

Don't Get Caught in "The Box" Unprepared

As we approach June 1 and the start of Hurricane season, many remember last year, as Hurricane Matthew hugged the east coast of Florida and Space Coast residence scrambled to secure their property, evacuate the coastal area and take shelter inland, sellers and buyers alike were urgently reaching out to their Real Estate Professionals asking what this could mean to their pending transactions.

The South Florida Real Estate Industry is all too familiar with the significance of "The Box" when it comes to a storm off the coast, but many home buyers and sellers are unaware of the term and what it means to their closing. Living in a coastal state where we have a six month (June 1 – Nov 30) Hurricane season that also happens to coincide with the busiest time in the Real Estate Industry for the state, it is important to understand the impact of a named

storm and how it may affect your closing, even if you are not in the direct path of the storm.

So what is "The Box?" It is an approximately 16,000 square mile area that is defined by the Hurricane Restriction Rule issued by the NC Joint Underwriters Association.. The rule states:

"No new or increased coverage shall be bound or application for new or increased coverage be accepted after 12:01AM the following day when the center of a designated named storm is located within Longitudes 65°

West and 85° West, and Latitudes 20° North and 37° North. The term "designated named storm" is a windstorm designated as a hurricane or tropical storm by the National Weather Service."

These coordinates form a box and encompass an area from Norfolk, Virginia down to the Dominican Republic and from from Apalachicola, Florida east to Bermuda.

It is important to understand that the issuing of new policies will STOP, whether or not the property is in the direct path of the storm and therefore this could happen well before any tropical storm warning or hurricane warning is issued by the weather service.

So how do you avoid a delay in your closing? While there is no guarantee, the best thing to do is file your

insurance application early; as soon as the offer is accepted and contract is signed by all parties. It is good to prepay and bind coverage early so your closing has a smaller chance of being affected.

In some cases, there is no way to avoid the delay. Most normal Florida contracts have a provision to extend closing date in the event of a storm and in most cases interest rate guarantees will be honored as well. And if by chance a storm hits, as in the case of Hurricane Matthew, lenders often require re-inspection of property and buyers and buyers and sellers may be required to sign a form attesting that they agree there is no damage.

Living in the lush tropics of South Florida it is best to follow these guidelines even outside of storm season when selling or purchasing a home. Don't get caught in "The Box" unprepared.










THE DOMINO EFFECT




